But since you had cardiac surgery 6 months ago, he wants you to stay in the hospital for observation. After Dr. Baker runs tests and reexamines you, if he thinks it is safe for you to go home then you will be on your way. All right?

Lena: Before this accident, did you walk by yourself without any support or did you need a cane or a walker?

Lena: OK. From the time you were brought into the hospital till now, have you walked?

Lena: That's right. It will take some time for your hip fracture to heal since your hip fracture has not been stabilized surgically. Physical Therapy will come to do an evaluation and help you when it is OK for you to start walking again.

Lena: After the doctor says it is Ok for you to get out of bed, be careful when you get up quickly. Your blood pressure medicine might make you feel dizzy and you might even fall.

Lena: Let me check the bed to make sure the bed is locked. Yes, it is locked and the head of the bed is at its lowest position. The bed side rails are up. The bed is very well secured. Here is the call-light. Press the button if you need any help. I or somebody else will come to help you, OK?
